Adrien Hébert is celebrated for his modernist style, and in his impressive oeuvre, captured the metropolitan bustle of Montreal's harbour and city streets. His compositions often include passing vehicles, horses, pedestrians, city architecture and market gatherings. As the son of renowned Montreal sculptor Louis-Philippe Hébert, student of William Brymner and admirer of the work of Impressionists such as Claude Monet and Alfred Sisley, Hébert had, from a young age, developed a keen eye attuned to the beauty of his everyday surroundings. The view of Place Jacques-Cartier was a favoured subject of Hébert's; the same locale is pictured in his 1939 painting The Market at Place Jacques-Cartier, in the collection of the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts. Through his expert handling of soft snowy greys and muted tones, Hébert deftly captures the calm streets and serene atmosphere of Place Jacques-Cartier in a quintessential Montreal winter.

Throughout her 42 year-long career as an art teacher, Doris McCarthy traveled extensively within Canada and beyond. In the years following her retirement in 1972, McCarthy embarked on annual trips to the Arctic, which she would continue until she was 94. Her polar explorations sparked her enduring passion for remote landscapes. In Antarctica from Above, a group of sculptural landforms and icebergs are silhouetted against a wash of soft sunlight and a fluid palette of violet, orange and glacial blues. McCarthy's aerial composition deftly captures the sublime and atmospheric qualities of the Antarctic and its surrounding waters, and is a striking example of her later work.

Mary Pratt's work is known for her fascination with light and its transformative effect on the spaces and objects of everyday life. Pratt's Bonfire series is an important departure from her finely-detailed still life compositions. Rather than capture the interaction between light and various objects, Pratt shows the immediacy and volatility of the firelight. Tom Smart notes that "in the bonfire drawings, she was able to represent light itself at the moment of its creation as it consumes matter". Pratt imbues the works in this fire series with a visceral sensibility, which echoes the energetic technique required to create her large-scale dynamic compositions. Smart writes that Pratt would "move around, use her whole body to make marks on the paper". According to Pratt, "the fire had to be alive," and the pliable, fluid medium of pastel allowed her to work quickly and expressively, echoing the unpredictability of a bonfire, and to transfer its dynamic, primal and ephemeral qualities onto paper.

After moving to Vancouver Island in 1980, Takao Tanabe began a series of atmospheric coastal panoramas. Traveling by boat between the mainland and the Island, Tanabe was inspired to capture the views of distant landforms and ocean mists on canvas. He began painting with a reductive realism that captured the sublime essence of British Columbia's coastal landscape. In this view of Johnstone Strait, Tanabe reveals the sky and mountain tops in the mirrored surface of the ocean. The coastline and sky are depicted in swaths of cool blues, verdant greens, long horizontal forms and soft white light, creating an expansive, meditative and transcendant space.
